- Fosters, promotes, and engages in aviation education through the Young Eagles Program, where students ages 8 to 17 receive aviation education and a free airplane ride donated by our membership.
- Sponsors the Aviation Explorer Post 218, for males and females 14 to 20 years of age learning about career opportunities in the aviation industry.
- Sponsors the Young Aviation Enthusiasts, for students ages 8-13 to learn about our "next step" program intended to cultivate the initial spark and keep interest alive until they are able to join our Aviation Explorer Post at age 14.
- Sponsors the Young Aviators program which puts 13 to 18 year old students in the pilot seat through daily simulator and aircraft training.
- Was founded in 1984 and continues to offer the Southeast Wisconsin Aviation Museum;
- Has hosted over 200 Boy Scouts to camp on weekends while working on Merit Badges, and hosted numerous schools attending an aviation day at the Chapter's building.
- Offers aviation education through ground school, a monthly newsletter, and a homebuilder's night to the public and members.
- Cooperates with and assists governmental agencies in the development of programs relating to aviation activities.
- Supports aviation safety in the design, construction, and operation of all types of aircraft.
- Promotes awareness of Racine through sponsoring various aviation events, like the Air Race Classic, rides in a B-17 or Ford Tri-Motor.
